



Changing the order of your photos

Your video is finished and the kitchen should have led. You don't have to start over. Drag the photos into the order you want and re-render the same listing, on the same link.

TIME

Two minutes to edit, about nine for the new video

COST

18 credits for a 16:9 video, shown before you commit

YOU'LL NEED

A computer — dragging doesn't work on a phone

1 Open My Videos and find the listing

Every finished video sits on its own card. Under the address you'll see how long it stays editable — **Editable for 31 more days**. Click the three dots  in the top corner of the card.

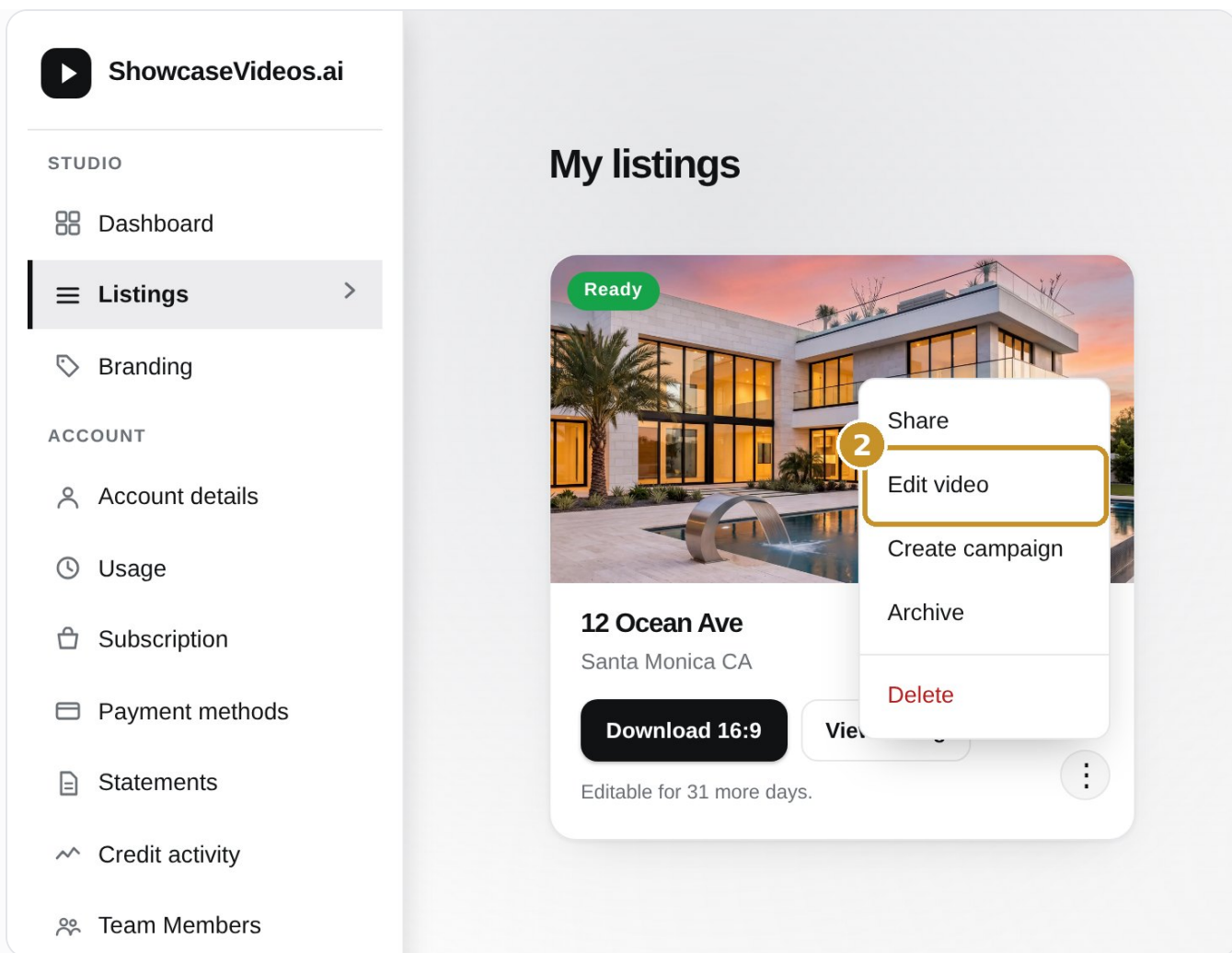

2 Choose Edit video

Pick **Edit video** ² from the menu that drops down.

There is a second door to the same page: open the listing and click the **Video Rendering** tile. Either one lands you in the editor.

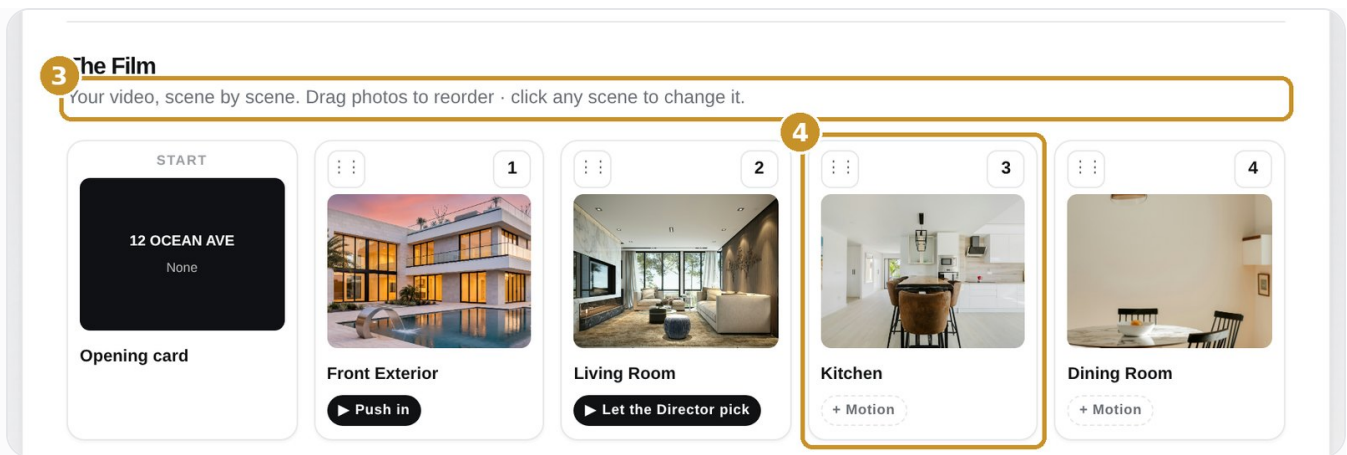
Don't see it? Editing closes 30 days after the video finishes, and the option quietly disappears with it. The video itself is unaffected — you can still watch, share and download it for good.



3 Scroll down to The Film

This is your video laid out scene by scene, left to right, in the order a buyer will watch them. The line under the heading **3** says it: **Drag photos to reorder · click any scene to change it.**

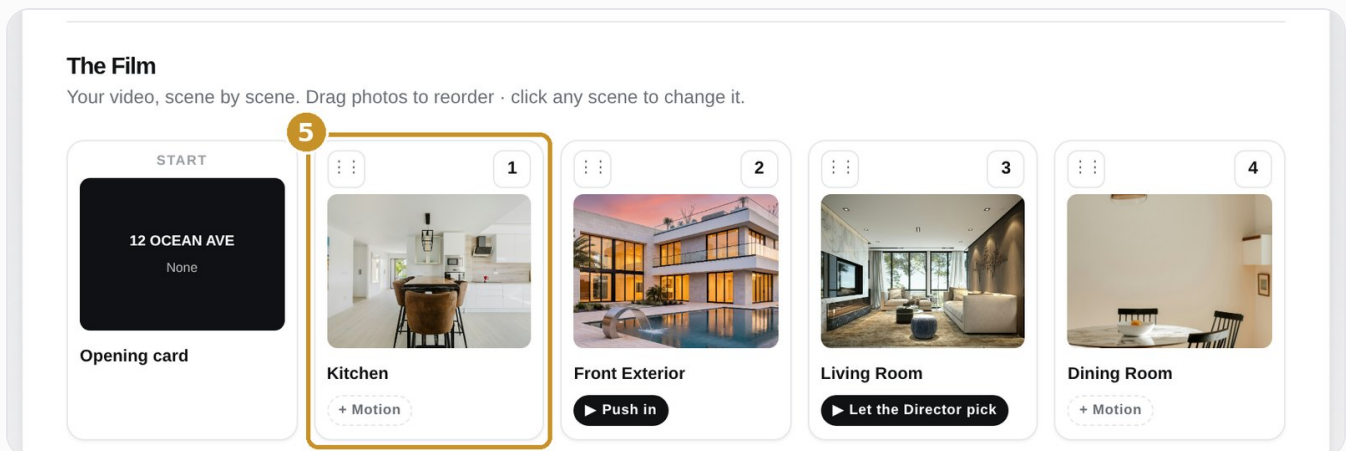
Find the photo you want to move. Here it's the kitchen **4**, sitting third.



4 Drag it where you want it

Hold the mouse button down on the photo, slide it along the strip, and let go. The other scenes step aside and renumber themselves. The kitchen is now scene one **5**.

Move as many as you like before going on. Grab the photo itself, not the room name underneath — clicking that renames the scene instead.



5 Check the panel on the left

It keeps a running list of what you've changed. **Photo order** has flipped from *unchanged* to **reordered** with a green check **6**, and **This edit** shows what it costs.

Nothing has been spent yet. Nothing has been saved yet either — if you close the tab now, the new order goes with it, and your browser will warn you before it lets that happen.

Re-render Video

Takes about 9 minutes. Anyone you already sent the link to will see the new version, **you don't need to send it again.**

Editable for 31 more days.

6 Click Re-render Video

The button at the bottom of that panel **7** wakes up as soon as there's something to re-render.

7 Confirm the credits

One last check before anything is spent:

Re-render this video for 18 credits? The current version stays online until the new one is ready.

Click OK and the new render starts.

Your motion shots, staged rooms and music are all reused, which is why an edit costs a fraction of the original video. The 18 is for a 16:9 video; if you produce extra formats the panel quotes the real number for yours.

8 Come back in about nine minutes

You'll land on the listing page and can watch it build. Nothing else to do.

Your share link does not change. Anyone you already texted or emailed the video to will see the new cut the next time they open it. You don't need to send it again.

Worth knowing

Use a computer, not your phone

Dragging a scene needs a mouse or a trackpad. The rest of the edit page works fine on a phone; the reorder doesn't.

You have 30 days

The clock starts when the video finishes rendering, and the card tells you how many days are left. After that the video is still yours to watch, share and download — it just can't be re-cut.

The old version stays up while the new one builds

Nobody hits a dead link in the middle of a re-render.

Order isn't the only thing you can change here

The same page takes a new address or price, different opening and closing cards, new music, your branding, and extra formats. Change several things and pay for one re-render.

Leaving without re-rendering loses the change

The new order lives in the page until you commit it. If you get interrupted, re-render or redo it later — it takes seconds.

Still stuck? Open the chat bubble in the bottom corner of any page and ask. A person can pick up that conversation if the assistant can't sort it out.
